
Malawi HIV prevalence

- Prevalence of HIV in Malawi estimated at 10.6% in 15-64 years population
- 12.8% for females and 8.2% for males
- This equates to approx. 900,000 PLHIV in 15-64 years age group

Heavily donor dependent

A 2012 study identified that Malawi would require almost 8% of its GDP to maintain its HIV position population on ART.

This makes Malawi the most dependent country in the world for outside funding for its treatment program.


